With the Public Health Orders currently in place to keep our facilities, staff, patrons, and kids safe we've devised a toolkit for you to utilize to make your time here the best it possibly can be!

### What [Public Health Orders](#) Are You Affected By At RCC

- When participating in Sport/Recreation (order 15, order 16, order 17, order 20, order 27, order 28)
  - o Masks
    - \_must be worn in common areas at all times (unless consuming food or beverage). This includes change rooms
    - Participants/coaches can take them off during practices
    - Participants/officials can take them off during games
    - Coaches must wear masks during games
  - o Proof of Vaccination
    - As of December 6, all participants of indoor recreational activities between the ages of 12 -17 will be required to show proof of at least one dose of vaccination, or a recent (within 72 hours) negative test result at the doors
    - Everyone over the age of 18 must be able to provide proof of vaccination to enter RCC (unless you have an provincially recognized exemption)
- When having a meeting
  - o Masks
    - Must be worn at all times throughout your time in the building (including while seated)
  - o Proof of Vaccination
    - Everyone over the age of 18 must be able to provide proof of vaccination to enter RCC (unless you have an provincially recognized exemption)
  - o Social Distancing
    - Social distancing is not required (as all participants should be vaccinated)
  - o Contact Tracing
    - Sign in at the front for contact tracing
- When hosting a private event
  - o Masks
    - Must be worn at all times (unless consuming food or beverage)
  - o Proof of Vaccination
    - Everyone over the age of 18 must be able to provide proof of vaccination to enter RCC (unless you have an provincially recognized exemption)
  - o Social Distancing

- As all patrons in the building are to be fully vaccinated, social distancing is not required

### Screening Clerks

- Recreational Activities/Events
  - Riverdale Municipality has hired screening clerks that ensure all patrons entering RCC are in compliance with the current Public Health Orders
- Private Events
  - It is the responsibility of the renter to ensure proof of vaccination is being verified.
  - Riverdale Municipality Screening Clerks may staff the door for you at an additional charge

### Negative Testing

- Negative tests need to come from a participating pharmacy as provincial testing sites should only be accessed by symptomatic individuals, or those who are required to take a PRR test by public health.
- Rivers Super Thrifty is NOT a participating pharmacy. Your closest appropriate testing option would be Brandon.

### Vaccination Passport

- Verified vaccination cards can be scanned on a paper copy, an immunization card, or a digital card
- Recommendations/tips for carrying your vaccination passport
  - Have 2 copies, digital and print
  - Give a copy to a teammate/teammates parent who you trust. This way if you travel with them, or forget yours, they will have a copy
  - Guardians, create a file on your phone with all of your families' passports. If you send your kids with other parents to games, send this file to them for easy access/backup
